7-12 July 2014

The agenda for the Council meeting to be held in Poitiers and Bordeaux reflects members' feedback and the priorities identified at Cairns Council. Members requested that we focus on a central theme. The theme for this Council will be "Effective School Leadership: Principal Training and Assessment." In addition the program provides members with many opportunities to interact and learn from each other including a focus on regional issues and activities, as well as the further exploration of the global issue of equity and access to education for all.

Prior to the meeting, data will be collected by the executive from Member Associations regarding Principal Training and Assessment structures and processes in their jurisdictions, and will be presented during the council meeting. In addition, associations will have the opportunity to share information and resources during a "marketplace" session. Following the council meeting, a white paper will be produced capturing our collective learnings.

Saturday, 12 July 2014, will offer a choice of social and cultural activities in Bordeaux.

Registration fees are all-inclusive. They include:

- the conference fees, meals including coffee breaks, and accommodation in Poitiers,
- one night’s accommodation in Bordeaux,
- the visit and dinner at Futuroscope,
- the transfer to Bordeaux by coach.

Not included:

- the optional activities, namely the Gala dinner on Friday night,
- the excursions on Saturday,
- a second hotel night in Bordeaux (Saturday 12 to Sunday 13) if desired.

Registration fees for accompanying spouses (250 €):

Included:

- the extra cost for the room for 4 nights in Poitiers and 1 night in Bordeaux,
- 5 breakfasts, 2 dinners at ESEN, 1 dinner and evening at Futuroscope,
- Transfer by coach from Poitiers to Bordeaux.

Early Bird registration fees – May 31, 2014

- Council Members (7 - 12 July) - 600 €.
- Accompanying participants – 250
- Gala Dinner (11 July) – 100 €
- Optional additional night’s accommodation in Bordeaux, July 12 – 13 – 145 €

After June 1, registration fees will be 660 € for Council Members and 275 € for accompanying participants.

Transport

All the participants must book their own flights and/or train tickets themselves.

Be careful: the place of arrival is POITIERS while the place of departure is BORDEAUX.

Indeed, all the participants must be aware that the first part of the Council Meeting will take place near POITIERS, which is accessible from PARIS by high speed train, either directly from the PARIS-CDG airport (duration 2 and ½ hrs) or from PARIS-MONTPARNASSE railway station (duration : 1hr

and 40 minutes, on average). If you have the choice, better choose to arrive at POITIERS-FUTUROSCOPE than POITIERS-Centre: it is nearer the hotel.

As people arrive at various times and dates, you will need to take a taxi to the hotel. We recommend Benham CHEGANI: 06 07 44 34 34. Or, from an international mobile phone: +33 6 07 44 34 34

Transport from POITIERS to BORDEAUX will be by coach and is included in the overall programme and registration fee.
